## About Oran Park Anglican College

Oran Park Anglican College (OPAC) is an inclusive Prep to Year 12, co-educational Anglican College in the heart of Oran Park. Our Christian faith is the motivation to pursue excellence and wisdom within a safe environment that values positive relationships and service.

Oran Park Anglican College was established in 2012 as a campus of Thomas Hassall Anglican College with 53 students, from Prep to Year 5. Strategically located in the centre of a thriving town, the College became an independent school in 2017 and now caters to over 1,100 students.

At the heart of the culture of the College are five values, reflecting our Christian beliefs and commitment to providing meaningful and personal learning experiences for every student. These values are: Courage, Curiosity, Craftsmanship, Collaboration and Compassion.

#### Teaching and Learning

In 2020, we launched the 'Powerful Learners' framework. This innovative model integrates content knowledge with character development, moving beyond traditional learning approaches. Using Guy Claxton's 'Learning Powered Approach,' it highlights how students learn and what strengthens learning capacities. Oran Park Anglican College has identified 5 core values: Courage, Curiosity, Craftsmanship, Collaboration, and Compassion. The framework encourages students to become powerful learners, and teachers to demonstrate these dispositions. We achieve this as a community by discussing learning, structuring activities, and defining good learning practices.

#### **Preparatory School**

At Oran Park Anglican College, we understand the importance of the early years in shaping a child's future success. We believe in the natural curiosity of young children, encouraging them to ask questions, explore their surroundings, learn to solve problems and develop friendships..

As part of our team, you will play a crucial role in harnessing this curiosity, using a balanced approach to help children become resilient, confident, creative, and adaptive learners. We measure student progress not only by academic achievements, but also by the development of character, relationships, and life skills that prepare them for success beyond Prep.

#### **Junior School**

In Junior School, we offer an engaging, holistic, Christ-centred curriculum. Our learning framework is designed to grow students into resilient learners and is underpinned by a restorative wellbeing framework designed to develop responsibility, repair harm, and improve relational strengths.



Staff adopt restorative and caring practices, walking pastorally alongside students as they develop.

- Covered Amphitheatre (due to open 2025)

- Performing Arts Centre providing performance space and Dance and Drama classrooms.



### **Our Christian Faith**

Our College nurtures and educates young people in accordance with the doctrines, tenets, beliefs and teachings of the Anglican Church Diocese of Sydney.

Oran Park Anglican College is a member of the Anglican Schools Corporation which supports Anglican Education. Our programs, curriculum, approach to pastoral care and discipline are informed and underpinned by the values, principles and truths contained in the Bible. What we believe influences what we do.

Our ethos is therefore both Christian and Anglican. Our Christian Studies Program, which is taught from Prep to Year 12, is designed to help students to understand Christianity so that as they mature, they can make an informed assessment of its relevance to their life.

All members of our team are personally committed to living by the beliefs and principles contained in the following statement:

- The fundamental truths of Christianity are contained in the Bible.
- The Bible declares that there is one God, who exists in three persons: the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.
- The purpose of the Bible is to bring people to salvation by trusting in Jesus Christ and to teach people the right way to live, so that they may be fully equipped for every good thing that God wants them to do.
- Jesus Christ was in very nature God, was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, was crucified, dead and buried. He rose again on the third day and will one day come again to judge the living and the dead.
- Only by faith in Jesus Christ can people be saved from the consequences of their sin, have assurance of forgiveness, the Holy Spirit's presence in their lives and eternal life.



### The OPAC Difference

Oran Park Anglican College aims to create powerful learners through the explicit teaching of key knowledge and skills to develop a lifelong love of learning. The OPAC Difference is gained from our unique mix of opportunities, academic rigour and knowing each student as an individual – made uniquely in God's image.

#### **Beyond the Classroom**

As a staff member at Oran Park Anglican College, you'll have the opportunity to guide students through enriching experiences that extend beyond academics. This includes opportunities such as student leadership, international study tours, outdoor education, peer support, Year 12 mentor program and more. These activities cultivate leadership, teamwork, resilience, and cultural understanding, all grounded in Christian values, supporting students in achieving both academic excellence and personal growth.

#### Co-curricular

The wide range of co-curricular opportunities allow students to develop their talents and skills, gain confidence and form friendships across all year levels. As a staff member, your personal passions and skills are highly valued in the education of our students. Teachers are encouraged to incorporate their own interests into our many co-curricular activities, enriching the overall learning experience.

#### **Christian Groups**

As a community, we aim to impact every member for Jesus. We provide spaces for students to deepen their understanding and relationship with Him through weekly CRU groups for Year 1 to Year 6 and LIFE groups for Senior School students.

#### **Creative and Performing Arts**

Students can explore their creativity through Dance, Drama, Music and Visual Art, with opportunities for ensemble participation, private and group Music tuition, various performance opportunities, involvement in CAPA groups and School musicals.

#### Sport

The College promotes an active lifestyle with diverse Sports opportunities such as Basketball, Netball, Football, Swimming, Tennis and Hockey, alongside annual events and higher-level competitions, supported by our state of the art Fitness Centre. Students participate in weekly Sport, including representative sport, Gala Days and other higher representative pathways.

#### STEM

Our Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) learning is enhanced through Clubs, offering activities like robotics, construction, puzzles, escape rooms, and coding, supported by breakout spaces, laptops, and codable robots to foster curiosity and knowledge expansion.

#### Other Clubs and Programs

#### Wellbeing

Oran Park Anglican College prioritises a safe, caring environment for students and staff, using restorative practices to teach respect and relationship-building. Student Wellbeing initiatives include the Buddy Program, Canine Support Program, College Counsellors and Chaplains, parent seminars, Pastoral Care and Peer Support.
